
Letter of Agency

Business Safety Tips

MAINTENANCE

- Keep walkways and seating areas clean and repaired.
- Remove all shrubs and bushes that create a solid barrier.
- Maintain your landscaping. Keep bushes trimmed below two feet and tree canopies trimmed up to six feet.
- Establish a maintenance plan that addresses potential graffiti, debris or landscape issues within 24 hours.

VISIBILITY

- Keep windows unobstructed to increase your visibility.
- Ensure your business address is clearly visible.
- Ensure that all areas are illuminated with proper lighting.
- Consider installing a video camera that will clearly record someone attempting to break into your business or a vehicle in your parking lot.

BOUNDARIES AND ACCESS

- Define your business boundaries with landscaping or fencing.
- Clearly define the entrances to your business and secure other possible access points.
- Install allowable signage, including parking, no trespassing and business watch signage.
- Repair any boarded up or makeshift fixes to your business.
- Make sure that emergency and maintenance personnel have working keys and access to vour property.
